1. There were no questions from the 4/26/2010 conference call.
2. The National Health Objectives for 2020 Coalition presentation at the Annual meeting was discussed. The Coalition's presentation will be implemented by Jim Grizzell, Bob Ward, George Brown and Cynthia Burwell. Jim will cover the Academic Impediments objectives as well as provide an overview of the Healthy People 2020 database. Bob will provide a historic perspective and specifically discuss the steps taken thus far by the Coalition. George will discuss the faculty and staff objectives while Cynthia will cover the student objectives. The presentation is in good shape and we are anticipating a large crowd. **Bob will take care of handouts, etc.**
3. Jim reported that the group working on the Academic Impediments objectives are proposing that we have 5 objectives specifically under the topic area, Academic Impediments. These objectives will cover the following areas: stress; cold/flu/sore throat; sleep; work; and anxiety. **This group will begin to work on the exact wording of the objectives.**
4. George reported that the Faculty/Staff Health Objectives group has made great progress. They have narrowed down the list to about 20 objectives and hope to have everything finished within the next couple of weeks. The group discussed using the Faculty/Staff Objectives as a pilot test for the layout and design of the final Healthy Campus 2020 "document." **Michelle will organize a conference call with George and Bob to discuss finalizing these objectives.** The July Coalition conference call will be devoted to the

Faculty/Staff Objectives. The current objectives will be sent out with meeting reminder/agenda for the July conference call.

5. The remainder of the conference call was spent going through the student objectives. The Coalition has a couple of remaining questions for ACHA leadership. **Michelle and Bob will contact these leaders within ACHA to help make decisions about the following objectives:**
  - a. MHMD #6: Should we list out with each illness? Lump together? If we list out, should we do top 5, 10, etc.? We will contact Coalition leadership.
  - b. STD #8: Further discussion with Craig Roberts.
  - c. HIV #1 & STD #8: Will ask Craig Roberts... should we use the ACHA Pap & STI Survey #47 only as it asks about those screened in the health center or would it be better to use the NCHA question?
  - d. Follow-up with Ann Quinn-Zobeck about ALA Oregon Survey... who gets this survey?
  - e. Follow-up with Ann Quinn-Zobeck about TU #1... should we ask only about cigarette use? Hookah? Smokeless?
6. The group decided that we will not have a call in June so the next conference call will be July 26<sup>th</sup> at 3pm EST.

Conference call was adjourned at 4:01 pm EST.
