1. There were no questions from the 12/14/2010 conference call.
2. Michelle briefly discussed several ACHA business related items:
  - a) The Coalition's proposed budget will be reviewed by the Board of Directors during their meeting the second week of February. Bob will be able to provide us with information regarding our budget by the February 22<sup>nd</sup> conference call.
  - b) The Coalition's midyear report will be submitted by Friday (the 28<sup>th</sup>). This report is used to update the Board of Directors on recent activities and areas of concern.
  - c) The Coalition's presentation during the Annual Meeting will be June 2<sup>nd</sup> (Thursday) at 1:45pm. The presenters will need two volunteers to serve as presiders and facilitators. Lori Dewald volunteered. **Anyone interested in volunteering for the other position should contact Cynthia Burwell ([cburwell@nsu.edu](mailto:cburwell@nsu.edu)) directly.**
3. Jim reported that he is still working with Sara to determine the best IVP objectives. He indicated that the objectives might be narrowed down to just two however there are several additional objectives that have strong measurable data available. **Jim and Sara will report their progress during the February conference call.**
4. Michelle proposed a question to the Coalition... should we follow Healthy People 2020's lead and have topic area(s) specific to certain populations? Healthy People 2020 have topic areas for populations such as older adults; adolescent health; lesbian, gay, bisexual, and transgender health; etc. The group agreed that at this point we should stick with health behavior based topic areas and explore topic areas around specific populations (e.g. international students, GBLTQ students, etc.) as an update to Healthy Campus 2020 as the

primary objectives need to be our focus. It was also noted that the only population based topic area being used by Healthy People 2020 that relates to our needs is lesbian, gay, bisexual, and transgender health and the Healthy People 2020 objectives have yet to be released in this topic area. Bob reminded everyone that the Gay and Lesbian Medical Association (GLMA) released a sister document to Healthy People in 2010 that specifically looked at the GLBTQ population's health issues/risks. The thought is that GLMA may do this again and we can reference their work.

5. Michelle reported that Jim will be leading a group of volunteers to address the issue of developing Academic Impediment objectives. Allison Smith and Jacque Hamilton volunteered to join Jim. **If you are interested in working with Jim, Allison and Jacque please contact Jim directly ([jvgrizzell@supomona.edu](mailto:jvgrizzell@supomona.edu)).**
6. George Brown reported on the progress of the Faculty/Staff objectives subcommittee. This committee is charged with establishing the Healthy Campus 2020 objectives specific to the faculty/staff population. This subcommittee is connected and active in the new ACHA Faculty and Staff Health and Wellness Coalition and will use this new Coalition as a sounding board as decisions are made. George noted that this subcommittee will meet via conference call the week of February 7<sup>th</sup> and again the week of March 7<sup>th</sup> (if needed). Michelle sent a meeting wizard request to the members of this subcommittee and will **notify everyone soon about the specific date and time of the calls.**
7. Cynthia informed the group that release of the *Dietary Guidelines for Americans, 2010* will be webcast live starting at 10:00am ET on Monday, January 31, 2011. Visit [USDA.gov/live](http://USDA.gov/live) to watch the release.
