Session Evaluation for all Meeting Attendees and Continuing Education Instructions

Step 1: Go to www.acha.org/AnnualMeeting19 to get the direct link to the Annual Meeting Continuing Education Center.

Step 2: Login using your last name and zip code used in registration.

Step 3: Those requesting **MCHES, AAFP, and ACPE** credit please review the notes at the bottom of the screen.

Step 4: If you **are** requesting continuing education credit, **select the type of credit you require.** (Note that you **cannot** request more than one type of credit.) If you **are not** requesting continuing education credit, **select the “Not Requesting Credit”** option. You must click on the “Submit” button to proceed.

Step 5: Click on the “Select Session” tab to select the session you want to evaluate.

Step 6: Click on the “Add” button, check the box to confirm that you attended the session in its entirety, and then click “Submit” to get to the Session Evaluation page.

Step 7: Complete the evaluation for the session you selected. (Refer to the attached worksheets.)

Step 8: Click on the “Select Session” tab to complete evaluations for additional sessions.

Step 9: When finished evaluating all sessions, click on the “View Transcript/Certificate” tab to review your transcript for accuracy.

Step 10: Click on the “Print/Email Certificate” button to complete the process. Note that you can’t print or email your certificate until you have evaluated all of the sessions you selected. Either click on the “Evaluate” button or click on the session number and remove the session from your transcript.
