- Tell your colleagues about the new ACHA membership model!
 - Institutional membership provides unlimited number of individual memberships
 - Pay up front for institutional memberships and each person signs up for own membership on their own--can join at any time
- Best Practices Toolkit
 - Organizational development tool using Stages of Change framework for implementing the Best Practices in your health center
 - Ideally a team would complete it
 - Identify barriers, determine how to best move forward with best practices
- Revising Best Practices framework
 - Want to make sure to infuse health equity into the document and acknowledge how oppression impacts sexual health
- Sexual Health Services Survey
 - Launching soon!
 - Allow health center staff to complete over winter break
 - One person on each campus will be sent survey; work as a team to complete the survey
 - Revisions coming in the next year: 2 sections = screening practices/surveillance, best practices toolkit (how well are you implementing the best practices)

 - Safer sex product funding sources (from ACHA Connect)
 - Funded through student fees

- Partnership with county--they have grant funding and share safer sex supplies with the college
 - Great American Condom Campaign--Advocates for Youth
 - Provide free condoms to students/student organizations
 - One Condoms may provide free condoms
 - One school wrote condom donation letters to local health departments, as well as to condom distributors to ask for condoms
 - Another school asked for donations from Good Clean Love, Lion's Den, WeVibe and they've sent free condoms and other supplies
- Social media (from ACHA Connect)
 - What does your office use?
 - One campus said their international students use Facebook more than any other platform
 - One school said their students really want them to do TikTok but their admins won't allow them to have it--put time into Instagram instead
 - One school posts blogs on Wordpress and then shares the links on Facebook and other platforms
 - Blogs correspond to weekly theme. Students write 1-2 blog posts.
 - Instagram weekly sexy tips--correspond with weekly theme
- What are ways that the Coalition can support you?
 - Menstrual equity
 - One school said their student government funds period product distribution on campus. Work with facilities management to refill products
 - Ever a need for an educational overview on molluscum contagiosum? Chris volunteered to do a webinar on that topic through pharm company
 - Referred to Robyn Buchsbaum at ACHA for collab opportunities
