	they wish to include author recognition in the work product. Authors of the work product may choose to opt-out of having their name listed. In order for an author to opt-out, they should notify the chair of the committee, taskforce, section or coalition of their request.  All recognition shall be standardized in a horizontal paragraph format that lists each author and their related credentials only. The name of the institution and position held shall not be included on the recognition
