Demographics of Participating Institutions

Fifty nine postsecondary institutions self-selected to participate in the Fall 2016 ACHA National College Health Assessment and 36,385 surveys were completed by students on these campuses. For the purpose of forming the Reference Group, only institutions located in the United States that surveyed all students or used a random sampling technique are included in the analysis, yielding a final data set consisting of 33,512 students at 51 schools. Demographic characteristics of the 51 campuses follow.

Number of Surveys (n) = 33512 P & W Surveys

A note about the use of sex and gender in this report:

Survey responses are reported by sex based on the responses to questions 47a, 47b, and 47c. For the purpose of the ACHA-NCHA report documents, respondents are reported as male or female only when their responses to these three questions are consistent with one another. If students' gender identity is consistent with their sex at birth AND the student selects "no" for transgender, then respondents are designated as either *male* or *female*. If a respondent selects "yes" for transgender OR their sex at birth is not consistent with their gender identity, then they are designated as *non-binary*. A respondent that skips any of the three questions is designated as *unknown*. Only 3 of the 4 categories are displayed in this report. Students categorized as *non-binary* are included in the *Total* column, but are not presented in a separate column. When the *Total* of any given row is higher than the sum of the *male*, *female*, and *unknown* students, the difference can be attributed to *non-binary* students that selected the response option presented in that row.
